
Gender-Affirming Health Benefits

Commonly-covered gender-affirming services

- Gender-affirming surgeries, including chest, breast, and genital procedures
- Hormone therapies and other pharmaceutical coverage
- Medical office visits and laboratory services
- Voice care
- Mental health benefits
- Family planning and fertility preservation
